

### New Permanent Supportive Housing Project Underway



Lacasa celebrated its newest building project, Benham Avenue Apartments, with a groundbreaking ceremony on July 8 at the site in Elkhart. Benham Avenue Apartments is a permanent supportive housing (PSH) property for homeless individuals in partnership with Oaklawn. It will be the fourth property in this program partnership since 2012.

"PSH is just one part of the solution in addressing homelessness," said Lacasa president/CEO, Chris Kingsley. "PSH is an extremely important piece by

providing an affordable, safe environment for as long as each individual needs it. Our partners at Oaklawn steadfastly work with our community members experiencing homelessness, and we recognize that it takes many types of housing to sustainably address the issues," continued Kingsley.

Bonita Schrock, Oaklawn's chief clinical officer said, "Housing is very important to both the physical and mental health of our community and we're excited to be a partner in this project to provide more housing in Elkhart."

When complete in spring 2020, Benham Avenue Apartments will consist of 11 one-bedroom apartments each with about 550 square feet of living space, along with a community room and laundry room. "Looking ahead to 2020, our 50th anniversary year, we're pleased that one of the first projects to be completed is Benham Avenue Apartments in Elkhart," said Kingsley. "It's one example of the ways in which multiple organizations can partner to address systemic issues and bring value to our community."
























## Financial Freedom Fair
